



Facilities

Classroom

Classrooms are well furnished, clean, bright, spacious and ventilated. Facilities or overhead and slide projectors are available in the classrooms. Besides, the number of students in each class is limited to thirty at the most.

Laboratories

Science Lab:- BGC has three subject wise laboratories: Physics, Chemistry and Biology, which are equipped with necessary science instruments and apparatus. All students are required to perform different practical experiments designed for them.



Hotel Management Lab:- It also has a separate and well-equipped Hotel Management Laboratory which is fully conducted by the professional Faculty Head. We have our own Restaurant and a kitchen in which we conduct both food and beverages demonstration renowned hotels for the advance knowledge of practical.

Games & Sports

Games and Co-curricular activities are the most important driving forces for personality development of the students. An experienced physical education teacher leads this dept. BGC has its own playgrounds for Basketball, Badminton, Volleyball and Table Tennis. The college administration enforces PT and games for all hostelers, and day scholars by organizing inter-house tournaments, trekking, picnics and educational tours, project works, camping, sight seeing, case study etc. The college organizes sports week and involves the students in different games for competition.



Library



BGC hosts a modern library with different books and periodicals of relevant fields. The students can have easy access to advanced references and text books, including literatures.



Computer Lab

The College has a well-equipped computer lab have been sufficient number of computers.



Cafeteria

A Well- furnished separate hall, equipped with electric water filter system, exits for the college canteen. Wholesome vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals are provided to the students by the college mess, which is managed by an able and qualified Mess Manager. Lunch and refreshment facilities are provided to the staff and students on reasonable pay. Students can enter the cafeteria only in break hours.

Transportation

The college provides transport facilities for the needy students. Transportation fee is charged monthly and it is in accordance with the distance between the pick-up and the drop off points of students.

Extra-Curricular Activities

All students are encouraged to participate in inter faculty and inter-college competitions, e.g. essay-writing, poetry writing, public speaking, elocution, debate, quiz etc. All the activities are conducted by students Council ECA Department. The winners are awarded with prizes and certificates in the annual functions.



Tour & excursion

Excursion is an integral part of education. Therefore, a well-organized educational tour will be arranged once a year for the students of higher secondary level. The college organizes visit programs to different places which have cultural and historical importance from times to times.



Medical

The college has a well-equipped. M.I. Room with sufficient First-Aid medicines which is operated by a professional CMA lady. The college maintains a high standard of hygiene and sanitation.



Examination

The whole academic session is divided into three terms with mid-terms in respect to internal examinations i.e. 1st term, 2nd Term and pre board. The main aim of these examinations is to know about the students' academic progress, weakness and take corrective action in their performance, and to maintain the standard for appearing Board exam.

1. Attendance of every student is compulsory in all terminal examinations. The Report of terminal exams will be issued to the preference of parents & guardians.
2. All the internal examinations will be conducted by department of Examinations, BGC according to college's operation calendar.
3. The parents/guardians will have to visit the college to receive the report of their wards of every internal exam.
4. Any inquiries regarding the student's academic performance the guardian can consult the Exam Department. The students and the guardians are always welcomed for their supports and constructive suggestions.
5. If any student spoils the norms and the rules of the exam, the examination department can forward or recommend the case to the principal for final decision.
6. The result of 2nd Term & pre-board exams of the students is considered prior to forwarding their exam forms to the TU & NEB.
7. The failure even in one subject or absentees in the terminal exams must give Re-exams. If any students fail the 2nd Term and pre-board exam will not be eligible to appear the final exam held by the NEB, and TU. This provision is applicable both in +2 and Bachelor's level.

The Following are the rules & regulation in order to maintain a high degree of discipline in the college premises. All students must abide by the rules and regulations of the college.

1. All the students must enter or leave the college on scheduled time in proper college's uniform.
2. A minimum of 85% attendance is required to appear in the Final examinations.
3. Students must produce leave application form signed by their parents/guardians whenever they go on leave.
4. Student should be holding their Identity cards while at the college.
5. Attendance of the students in all subjects will be recorded daily. Those who are absent in the classes are required to produce letters with a reasonable excuse either from the parents or from the guardians.
6. Students must not leave the class room except during breaks as scheduled in the daily routine.
7. The students concerned must compensate any damage to the property of BGC.
8. Students are prohibited to wear jewelry, cosmetics, keep and color nails and any unfit items.
9. All payments should be done in time.
10. Hair style of students must be normal. The boys must trim hair short, coloring and dyeing of hair and other odd seeing styles will not be tolerated.
11. One who commits the major breaches of the college rules will be terminated from the college. The following are considered to be the major breaches of the college rules:
 - a) Repeated violation of college rules.
 - b) Vandalism or theft of school or personal property.
 - c) Endangering the safety of others.
 - d) Fighting, bullying, harassing or threatening fellow students.
 - e) Cheating, lying other forms of unethical or immoral acts.
 - f) Smoking, using drugs and other alcoholic items.
 - g) Causing a disruption or disturbance to school environment.
 - h) Discourteous or disrespectful behaviour .
 - i) Obscenity of any kind and use of abusive or rude language.
 - j) Physical assault or dishonesty of any kind.
 - k) Disobedience and disrespect towards teachers or other staff members of the college.
12. The principal reserves the right to expel or suspend or terminate the student who does not follow BGC rules and regulations.
13. Students must attend the re-exam conducted by college who fails in the term exam.
14. One who bunks the class will be penalized Rs. 500/- in his/her every bunks.
15. The absentees must show the reason for being absent and produce of proof of sickness otherwise he/she shall be charged Rs. 200/- as penalty.

Admission Procedures

Admission will be valid on a prescribed application form. It can be received from the front desk.

BGC conducts the screening of applicants through entrance exam. It will be on Science, Mathematics and English for Science stream and on Mathematics, English and General Knowledge for Commerce and Humanities. The Final selection will be done on the basis of SEE score and screening test. The selected candidates must submit all necessary documents and pay the fees within one week to ensure their admission. The student who has bad record or bad character will not be given any chance in BGC.


