

Eligibility for Admission

The candidate applying for BSc.CSIT program must have:

- Successfully completed +2/PCL in science or its equivalent from any University, board or institution recognized by Tribhuvan University.
- Applicants are required to appear in the entrance test conducted by Institute of Science and Technology, Tribhuvan University (ISOT-TU) and should secure at least 35% marks in order to be eligible.
- The candidate must have completed 10+2 or equivalent examinations with Minimum 'C' grade in all subjects of grade 11 and 12 by taking Physics and Mathematics of 100 marks.

(Note: Both Biology and Mathematics group of students of +2 level are eligible to apply for the course)

Curriculum Structure

The BSc.CSIT program will have eight semesters with 126 credit hours. Each semester shall have duration of 6 months (Minimum of 15 weeks to maximum of 20 Weeks). All the subjects carry 3 credits each. This program comprises of the following courses:

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Students who have passed grade 11 and are waiting for supplementary exam (PURAK PARIKSHA) of grade 12 can also apply. However, they have to submit all the required documents at the time of admission.

Applicants are required to appear in the entrance test conducted by Institute of Humanities and Social Science, Tribhuvan University and should secure at least 35% marks in order to be eligible
