- Application Process: Apply either in person or online. Application form fee: Rs. 2,500.
- Selection: Candidates must appear for the entrance test. Shortlisted applicants will be invited to enroll.

PGDHCM – Post Graduate Diploma in Healthcare Management (33rd Batch)

- ✓ Eligibility: Bachelor's degree in any discipline (Health Sciences, Management, Public Health, Social Sciences, etc.).
