# ADMISSION PROCEDURE



- Admission forms along with the Prospectus shall be made available at the administrative office of the school on the payment of Rs. 100/-
- Forms will be distributed from 9:00am to 4:00pm during college days.
- An entrance test of one hour in English, Nepali, Mathematics and Science shall be taken to assess the ability of the student.
- Final selection shall be made on the basis of interviews.
- The following documents should be submitted for admission:

  3. 4-passport size photos
  4. Migration Certificate (for the migrating students only)

## DANCE 4 LIFE

BHSS-AIC is affiliated with a Dutch organization whose local office is managed by an INGO called Students Partnership Worldwide. Dance4Life is one of the largest international youth movements involved in fighting the spread of HIV/AIDS. Currently, SPW has offices in Nepal, India, Australia, Sierra Leone, South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda, UK, USA, Zambia and Zimbabwe. SPW Nepal is registered with the Government of Nepal since 1991, and partners with local NGOs, local communities and schools to implement its youth focused programs on Sexual Reproductive Health, Life-Skills and Livelihood. SPW Nepal works in partnership with Dance 4 Life in Nepal to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS through engaging youth.





## CURRICULUM

The BHSS-AIC management programme focuses on encouraging students to achieve beyond the boundaries of a single academic discipline. The management programme offers interdisciplinary curriculum to ensure intellectual growth and lay ground work for successful career. The college offers students with standard HSEB curriculum supported by other relevant studies such as research, communication, computer, writing skills, etc.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

BHSS-AIC admits students only on the basis of standardized entrance test. The basic eligibility requirement is SLC or equivalent with 1st Division.

Admissions: June – July

Classes Commence: 2nd week of July

The key distinctive features of BHSS are the well paced Plus Two level programme, the close rapport between students and teachers and the predominantly classroom-based curriculum delivery. Class sizes are small, averaging 35 students.
